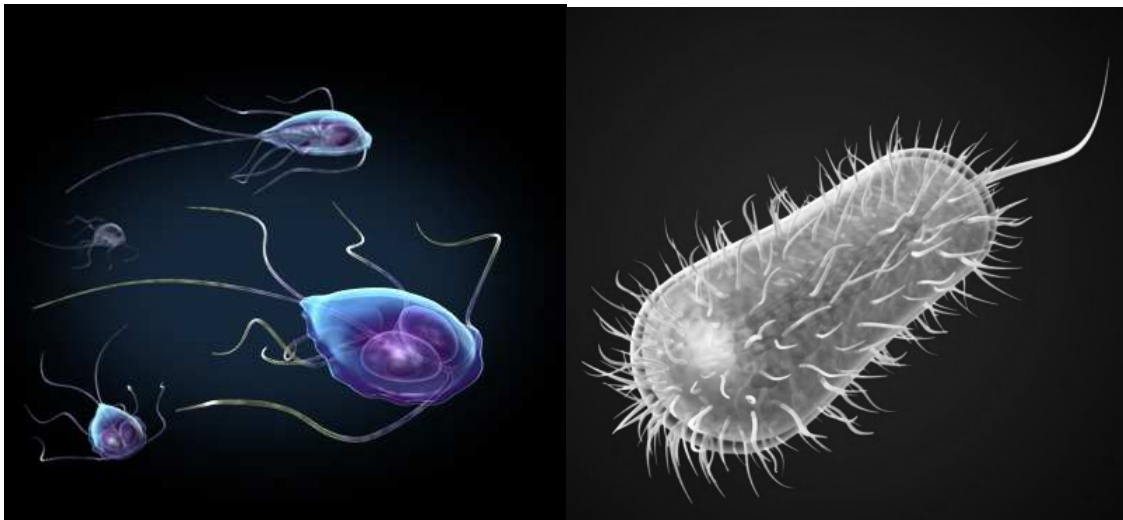

The relationship between all life forms and microorganisms has been clearly identified but is still not well understood. The technology of EM (Effective Microorganisms) has been in existence for over 20 years and over that time, has produced significant positive results but has still not achieved wide-spread acceptance or recognition.

This talk will cover the basics of the technology, beneficial applications to the fields of animal & human health, soil management, agriculture, water quality, waste treatment and environmental re-cycling. The economics and cost saving implications will be briefly covered. An array of possibilities for development of the technology in conjunction with the scientific community will be raised in order to expand the use of the technology and produce significant improvements in our environments.
